**Federal Firearms Registration Program**

- WHEREAS** The New Brunswick Association of Chiefs of Police fully supports the development of a National Firearms Strategy for law enforcement with regards to the registration of all firearms in Canada and;
- WHEREAS** The New Brunswick Association of Chiefs of Police agree to sanction said initiative at the request of the Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police and;
- WHEREAS** The Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police is pursuing support from New Brunswick Association of Chiefs of Police members governing bodies for said strategy development and maintaining the Firearms Registry and the registration of all firearms.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the New Brunswick Association of Chiefs of Police calls upon the Minister of Public Safety to support a Federal Firearms Registration Program for all firearms as an essential tool in advancing safe communities, and that such support be communicated to the Government of Canada during any consultations on the Firearms Act, or any other appropriate forum.
