As a result of the devastating attacks on September 11, 2001 on the United States, security measures of not only Americans, but citizens of every country, have been heightened to ensure such an act of violence cannot happen again. The issue of global terrorism and how to fight and prepare for any attacks has led many public safety agencies to develop new policies and procedures to help with the prevention and response efforts. This award has been developed to bring well deserved recognition to those first responders who perform tirelessly each and every day whether during normal operations or training exercises

Who Can Apply?

Eligibility

The award is open to all public safety agencies with the exception of private corporations (as a standalone). Individuals, teams, or groups such as agencies, divisions, sections, and detachments are eligible. Partnerships between police services, fire, and emergency medical agencies are also eligible and encouraged. Cross border teams and those consisting of public/private partnerships are also encouraged.

To Enter...

To enter, each agency must submit a description of its local project or process that details how well it has achieved one or more of the five award goals. Agencies can submit multiple applications for multiple projects. Every submission will undergo peer review by a special award panel of public safety professionals. Annually, three awards will be presented in categories of Federal, Provincial, and Municipal
