RECOGNIZING SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY



SURVEILLANCE

Showing unusual interest in or taking pictures/video of people, buildings, security features, or surrounding areas.



ACQUISITION OF CAPABILITY & MATERIALS

Trying to obtain or conduct training in security concepts. Collecting materials such as cell phones, toxic substances, and weapons.



BREACH OR ATTEMPTED INTRUSION

Unauthorized people getting into a restricted area, system or protected site, or impersonating authorized personnel, which can include theft of uniforms or access badges.



SABOTAGE, TAMPERING OR VANDALISM

Damaging, manipulating, or breaking part of a facility, infrastructure, or secured site.



TESTING OF SECURITY

Interactions with, or challenges to personnel or systems that show physical, personnel or cyber security capabilities. This might look like suspicious items/packages, trying to get private information, and diversionary tactics.



EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED THREAT

Making or communicating a threat to harm or kill people or damage a facility, infrastructure, or secure site.
