### **CACP Candidate Eligibility Criteria**

The following criteria will be applied in determining candidates for this program;

- Must be a CACP member in good standing
- Holds a senior executive level position such as a Deputy Chief, Superintendent, or equivalent in rank or an equivalent senior civilian police executive.
- Plans to stay active in the field of policing for a minimum of 5 years
- Holds a bachelor's degree or equivalent career experience and education
- Have a career goal of becoming Chief of Police or equivalent

\*Consideration will also be given to recently appointed Chiefs who may be interested in developmental opportunities

### **Application Check List**

Candidates must complete the application form and submit a package that includes the following;

- ☐ A description of career goals and steps taken to achieve them
- ☐ A demonstration of commitment to life-long learning
- ☐ An outline of learning and mentoring needs as well as expectations from the program to facilitate alignment with a mentor
- ☐ A confirmation of commitment to participate in all program sessions and activities
- ☐ A resume (no more than 4 pages)
- ☐ A photograph (headshot of publishable quality)
- ☐ A letter of endorsement from your Chief of Police or equivalent

### **Confirmation Policy**

All candidates are subject to approval by the CACP and are not considered approved until all application materials are received and reviewed. Candidates will receive confirmation of approval by June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025, after which registrations will be considered final and not subject to cancellation with refund.
