1. What is The Skilled Leader Series?

4. When will the workshops run and what if some of the dates don't work for me?

The workshops are scheduled to run live across three separate dates: October 16, 2025, January 15, 2026, March 19, 2026. The series is virtual and recorded for flexibility. If a participant is not able to attend live, they can still participate through the recorded version.
