This strategic thinker will be visible in the community, partnering with agencies and social service providers to coordinate policing in the City of Guelph, while maintaining a safe and secure community. This critical role requires a transformational and innovative leader whose vision is to address the complex issues and challenges facing policing.

Qualifications:

A post-secondary degree and/or equivalent of education and experience is required. Must be a sworn senior police officer with a minimum of five years in a senior management position with full responsibilities and accountability for financial and human resources. Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills is a requirement. Demonstrated ability to design and provide client focused services, to be an innovative and resourceful leader in developing teams, and to think and act strategically and innovatively is essential. Excellent police operations technical expertise including financial management and knowledge of human behavior is necessary for this challenging position. Demonstrated strong ethics, integrity and commitment to professionalism is a requirement.
