2016-17 Message from the Co-Chairs

The Co-Chairs are pleased to present the 2015-16 CACP International Policing Annual Report on behalf of the Committee members. This report provides a synopsis of the Committee's work over the course of this past year.

There has been one in-person meeting over the past year at last year's CACP Annual Conference in Ottawa as well as several individual and group telephone conferences as indicated below. Committee meeting dates and locations are scheduled to minimize travel costs, and where possible, occur in conjunction with other CACP functions. The International Policing Committee is scheduled to meet for a two-hour period on Sunday, July 16, 2017, immediately in advance of the CACP Annual Conference in Montréal.

Accomplishments

What Happens There Matters Here (WHTMH) Conference

The above-noted conference was held in Ottawa from September 26-27, 2016. A highly interested group of attendees participated in this unique conference which brought diverse perspectives on the issue of how global events have impact locally in Canada. The Conference addressed policing and community safety in an increasingly globalised world with a particular emphasis on building knowledge and awareness around the connection between global events, local community safety, trust and cooperation.

CACP International Policing Award

The award is intended to recognise Canadian law enforcement personnel for their exceptional dedication and initiative in using Canadian policing skills to contribute to a safer world, and seeks to encourage more Canadian police services to contribute to and work on the international scene. This year's call for submissions resulted in nine separate submissions being received. This year's recipient is the Calgary Police Service for its work in the context of Operation Hydra & Intrigued, a multi-faceted investigation for murder and controlled substances which spanned North America. The award will be presented at the 2017 CACP Conference in Montréal in July.

Mandate

The mandate of the International Policing Committee is to inform and advise the CACP's Board of Directors and its members on best practices in policing from across the world in an effort to improve Canadian policing practices.

Committee Priorities

- Encourage and facilitate communications amongst members of the Committee, the CACP and CACP Board of Directors regarding international policing practices, issues and trends.
- Recognise best practices of Canadian law enforcement personnel through the awarding of the International Policing Award.
- Supporting the CACP's Global Studies Program.
- Address international policing issues as identified and instructed by the CACP Board of Directors and membership.

Goals and Objectives for 2017-18

The International Policing Committee will be identifying goals and objectives for the next year at its Montréal meeting to be held on July 16th.
